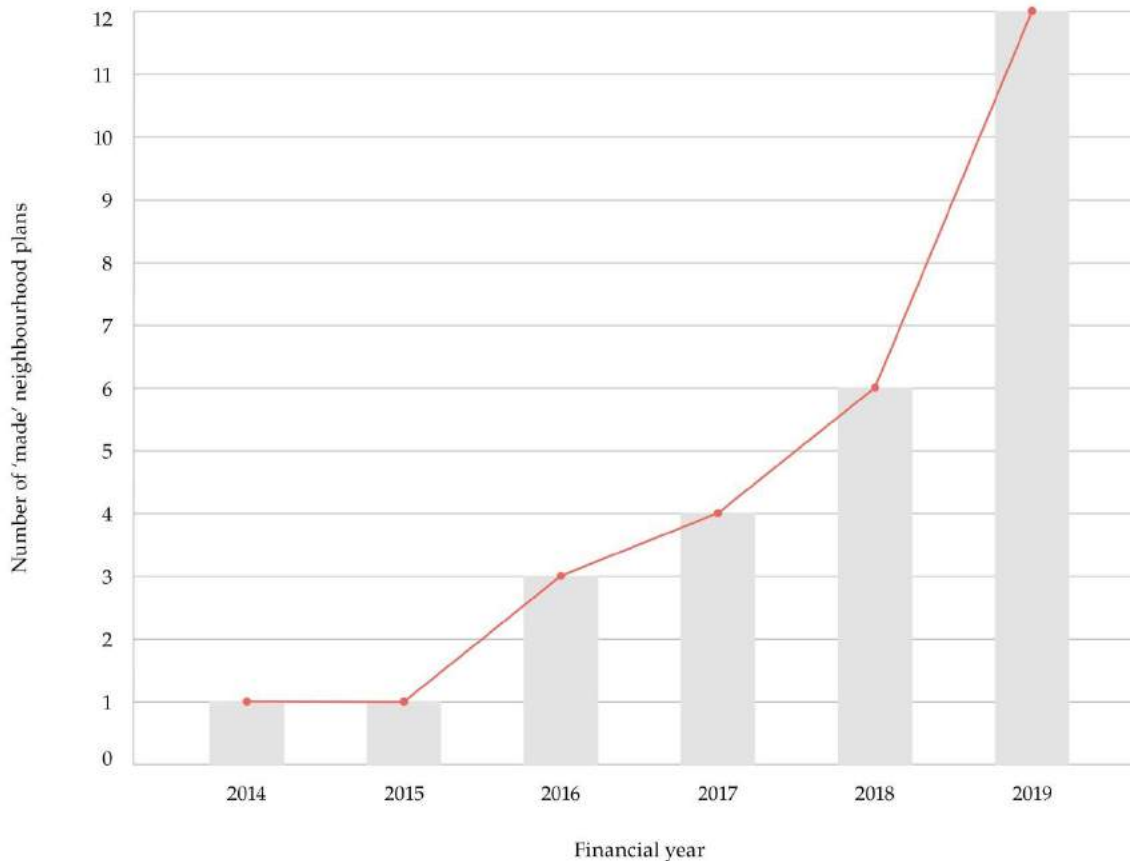

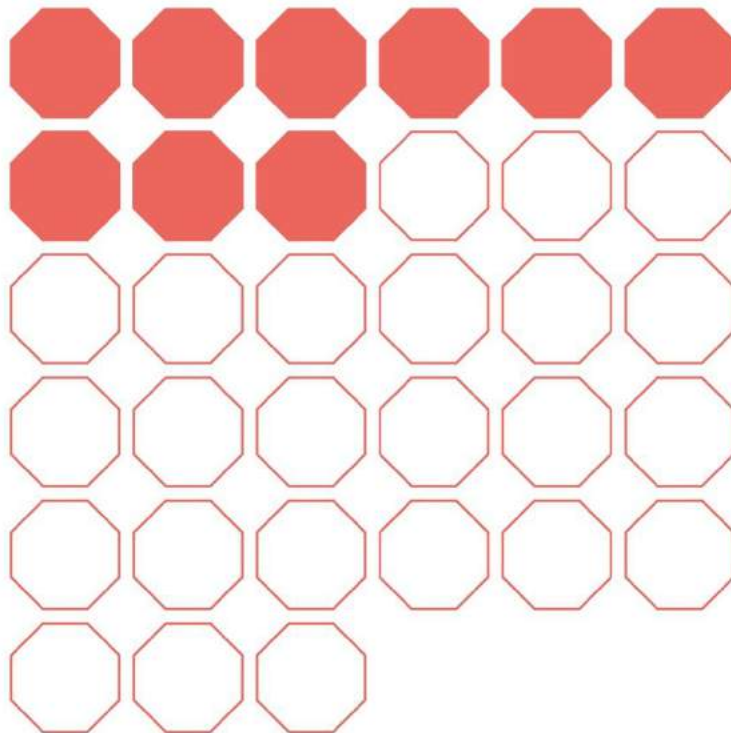

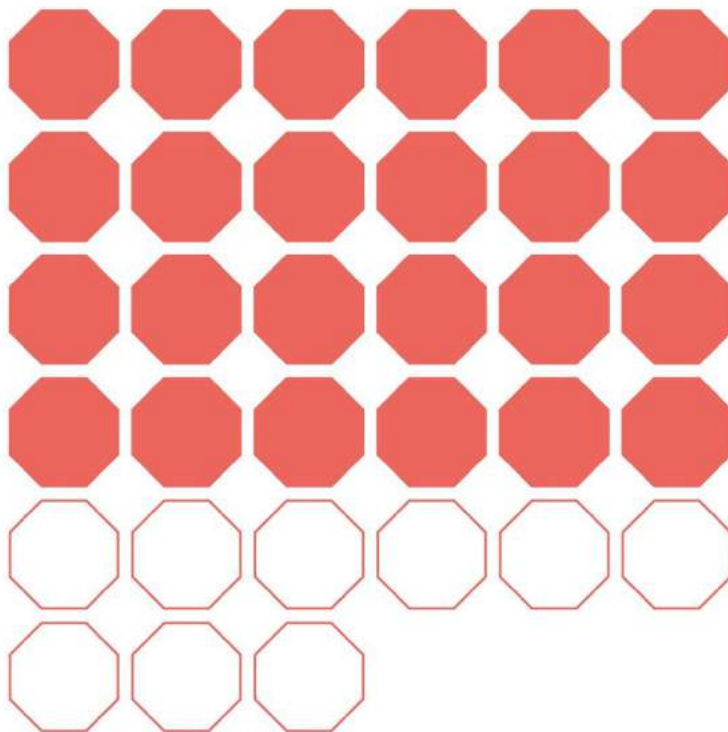
NINE OUT OF 33 BOROUGHES IN LONDON ARE

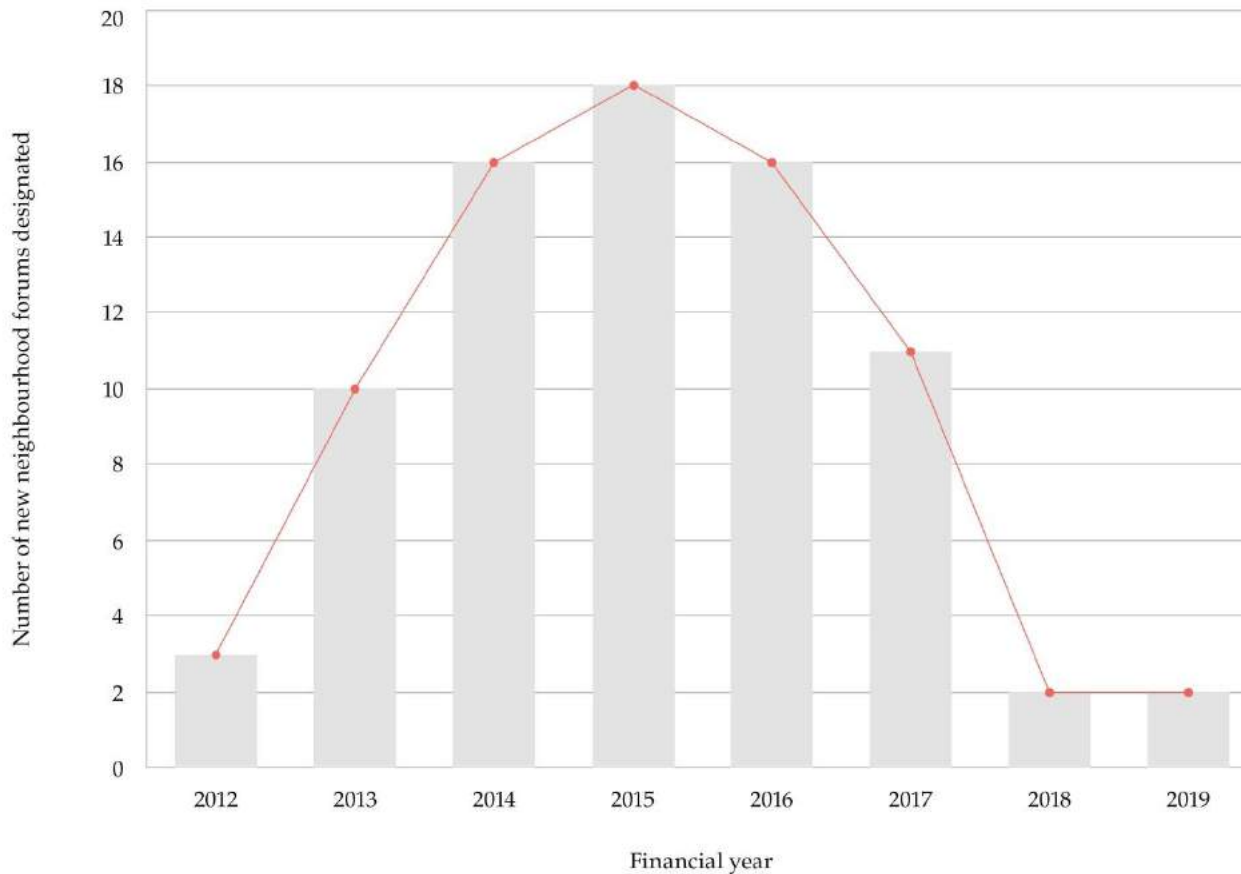
